Description Olive drab colouring with yellow markings.

Hollow ogive crimped onto the body, a body union fitting into the base of the body with internal threads to receive the motor, and a fuze located in the forward end of the

motor tube.

Function Used by the infantry against tanks,

armoured fighting vehicles and pillboxes. Could also be used as a stationary emplacement for demolition or as an anti-

tank mine or a booby trap.
